School board receives installment check



Members of the board of trustees of the Del Mar Union School District were presented a symbolic check for \$2.8 million on Oct. 30 representing the first installment of funds for purchase of the district's Ninth Street or Shores property. Through fundraising efforts in the community the city of Del Mar is attempting to complete a deal that will transfer ownership of the property to the city.
